

Intern, Monitoring and Evaluation

STIR Education is a fast-growing international NGO, currently operating in India and Uganda.

STIR's aim is to address the learning crisis in the developing world by empowering teachers to be changemakers. We support teachers to re-imagine their role in leading change in their classrooms, schools and the wider education system. We see teachers as the solution to the learning crisis, rather than the problem.

Having launched in Delhi, India 4.5 years ago with just 25 teachers, there are now 12,000 teacher changemakers across India and Uganda, working in government, NGO and affordable private schools. Our vision is to have 120,000 teacher changemakers in the movement by 2020, impacting learning for 4.5 million children. By 2024, we aim to have 1 million teachers in the movement, impacting learning for around 40 million children.

The Position

Your role in the Monitoring and Evaluation team will be

- To analyse and communicate trends from monitoring and evaluation data for data driven decision making across the organisation
- To review literature on teacher motivation, classroom practice, system embedding and reform
- To design, conduct, and analyze qualitative and quantitative studies in government schools across Delhi, Uttar Pradesh, and Karnataka.
- To research and evaluate technology solutions for real-time monitoring and evaluation of STIR operations and design

You will have the opportunity to learn different techniques of analyzing qualitative and quantitative data using NVivo and STATA. There will be additional opportunities to learn about other aspects of the program.

You will be working with Monitoring and Evaluation associates in India amongst a global Monitoring and Evaluation team.

Background

- Pursuing or completed an undergraduate or post-graduate degree in education, economics, psychology, sociology, social work, development studies or any other social science
- Prior experience of qualitative and quantitative data analysis
- Prior experience of conducting secondary research
- Proficiency in speaking and understanding Hindi and English (or Kannada)

Dates and duration

The internship is based in Delhi and begins in June, with a minimum commitment of 3-6 months, which can be extended based on further requirements. Extensive field work in either Delhi, Uttar Pradesh, or Karnataka.
